The meeting was organized by The Roumanian Society of Chemistry in cooperation with DAC of EUCHEMs, Roumanian International Scientific Chapter of the American Chemical Society, and Roumanian Academy. The meeting was dedicated to the 150th Anniversary of the Roumanian Academy.

There were 125 participants, 18 from abroad (Bulgaria, Egypt, France, Germany, Hungary, Latvia, Moldova, Poland, Serbia, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey) and the rest from 19 institutes/universities in Roumania (located in Bucharest, Cluj-Napoca, Constanța, Galați, Iași, Râmnicu Vâlcea, Snagov, Timișoara). During the opening ceremony were presented the slides of DAC by George Horvai, and also the next EUROANALYSIS meetings were advertised by their chairs.

The scientific meeting will include 11 scientific sessions with 9 plenary lectures, 14 keynote lectures and 20 short lectures, as well as 5 poster sessions with 50 presentations.

Two prizes were awarded during the opening ceremony for outstanding contributions to analytical chemistry. The prizes were given by the Roumanian International Scientific Chapter of the American Chemical Society:

1. George Emil Baiulescu award and medal – for an established researcher with excellent contribution to the field of analytical chemistry to Professor Hassan Y. Aboul-Enein, Cairo, Egypt. The prize was sponsored by ProAnalysis – 380Euro.
2. Constantin Luca award and medal – for a young researcher under 35 years old (jury members: Hassan Y. Aboul-Enein, Sibel Ozkan, Oana Leonte) to Dr Livia Alexandra Gugoasa, National Institute of Research for Electrochemistry and Condensed Matter, Laboratory of Electrochemistry and PATLAB, Bucharest, Roumania. The prize was sponsored by Oana and Dinu Leonte, USA – 200USD.

Six prizes were awarded for posters and oral presentations (jury members: Hassan Y. Aboul-Enein, George Horvai, and Charlotta Turner) to young researchers:

Best oral presentation: Grigorina Mitrofan (Roumania), Roxana Balahura (Roumania), Sevin Kurbanoglu (Turkey).

Best poster presentation: Grigorina Mitrofan (Roumania), Gabriela Ailiesei (Roumania), Georgiana Luiza Arnold (Roumania).

The next meeting will be organized in 2018 – the same period of time in Constanța or Brașov.
